OPEN ACCESS CYSTOSCOPY SERVICE

Referral Guidelines

This service is designed to provide a fast and efficient assessment procedure for Leeds patients presenting with haematuria.

To provide appropriate investigations for patients in a primary care setting.

INDICATIONS FOR REFERRAL TO OPEN ACCESS SERVICE:

- Patient with persistent painless haematuria for which there is no evidence of urinary tract infections, and are amenable to primary care investigation
- Recurrent female Urinary Tract Infection as outlined in the protocol **3**

CONTRA-INDICATIONS FOR REFERRAL TO OPEN ACCESS SERVICE:

- 14 days cancer referrals
- In general, persistent frank haematuria would be advised to be sent as cancer referral direct to the Urology department

How to make a referral

By sending a referral letter with the patient's current telephone number, with the result of a recent Urea and Electrolyte, Urine Microscopy and Culture, and Cytology, to
